We will also continue to foster our relationship with Q-PEN in particular through our involvement in a 'benchmarking exercise' we were invited to participate in, as well as engaging with our critical friend, Christine Grimmer, from Griffith University. We will also look at ways of increasing our presence online, including on social media platforms. To inform our strategy, we will undertake a short survey of project team members and workshop attendees to ask them how they publicise and find out about events and what sort of social media they use.
